
WHAT IS THE PRE-TRAINING PRINCIPLE?



PRE-TRAINING PRINCIPLE



Expose learners to new instructional material with no prior supporting documents or multimedia







PRE-TRAINING PRINCIPLE



Provide learners with key terms and concepts in advance through supporting documents or multimedia that gives them basic understanding of the instructional material








PRE-TRAINING PRINCIPLE

People learn better from a multimedia lesson when they know the names and characteristics of the main concepts.

Example: Providing a learner a guide that introduces key terms and concepts **before** exposing them to the actual material.
